


ABOUT EAGLE OAK RETREAT

② OUR FACILITIES

Eagle Oak Retreat rests on an 11-acre ranch in rural, Italy, Texas. The retreat is surrounded 65-acres of oak trees, beautiful horse pastures, and a quaint fishpond. The retreat is fully ADA-accessible and features two bunk houses, an iron kettle kitchen, a horticulture heroes garden, an archery range, and a peaceful healing garden.











The Round Up is a 3,800 sq ft custom designed building crafted by Legacy Post & Beam that boasts vaulted ceilings and gorgeous views of the pastures. The Round Up serves as a flex space – providing offices for staff, conference & meeting space, and dedicated classroom space for our training programs.





The Bunkhouses are 3,500 sq ft each and are fully ADA accessible. Each house is custom designed, featuring 8 bedrooms with 4 Jack & Jill restrooms, an entry lounge area and a wrap around porch with outdoor seating. Bunkhouses are available to our students and guides during the PATHH program and Family R&R programs



The Iron Kettle dining hall is a 3,800 sq ft custom designed building crafted by Legacy Post & Beam. It features vaulted ceilings, a state-of-the-art commercial kitchen that will serve as the gathering place, bringing farm-to-table concept recipes that will nourish our students and their families.





Programs Offered at EAGLE OAK RETREAT

Eagle Oak Retreat currently offers Boulder Crest Foundation's Warrior PATHH program. We are in the process of planning and preparing the Family Rest and Reconnection program for the fall 2023.













Progressive & Alternative Training for Helping Heroes

Eagle Oak Retreat is the newest location in the country to offer the groundbreaking PATHH program developed by the Boulder Crest Foundation — the leaders in the field of posttraumatic growth for our returning combat veterans, first responders, and their families.



Who is Eligible for PATHH?

Warrior PATHH is available to men and women combat veterans and first responders. No clinical diagnosis or prior mental health care is required to participate.

- Participants MUST be active, retired, or separated from service.
 We support all military, first responder, reservists and National Guard members.
- We define a "combat veteran" as anyone who has deployed, or supported a combat zone.
- We define a "first responder" as anyone who serves their community as a Police Officer, Sheriff's Deputy, Fire Fighter, EMS, Health Care Worker, or any Federal Law Enforcement or Intelligence Agency personnel.

Why Warrior PATHH Works

Warrior PATHH is built on the decades-old science of Posttraumatic Growth

Warrior PATHH is built on a foundation of transparency, honesty, and mutuality. We do not ask anything of participants that our guides are not doing or have not already done

Warrior PATHH taps the natural skills, abilities and resources of Warriors

Warrior PATHH connects Warriors who are on similar paths and builds new teams that hold each other accountable

Warrior PATHH utilizes small group sizes (8 participants) and low instructor to student ratios

Warrior PATHH represents years of effort, experience, and understanding into precisely what is required to ensure our Warriors can come all the way home
